6. Director reports

President – Mike Harding – interesting season but always had the goal of keeping the kids on the ice safely. Thanks to everyone for making this happen.

Past President – Todd Copeland – last 2 years, our priority has been to keep kids playing hockey. This has resulted in a higher level of commitment of all of our directors. Thanks to everyone.

Treasurer – Randy Sheaves – received direction from OMHA that organizations are no longer permitted to collect gate fees. Our registration fees have not changed in the last 5 years. For the upcoming season, a \$100 fee will be added to both OMHA and OWHA registration fees to offset game expenses such as referee costs. Bank account balances and projected budget were reviewed.

Question – Would this additional \$100 fee be per player or per family? Answer – Per Player. Question – Does this also include playoffs? Answer – Yes. There will not be gate fees collected during playoffs or tournaments.

Question – is this gate fee cost separate from the girls' gate fee cost? Answer – This \$100 fee replaces the previous \$85 fee for girls' and is now the same for both girls' and boys' hockey. It will not be applied to any IDP players.

Secretary – Tichelle Schram – Role includes documenting all meetings and posting on website for our membership to review. As well, communication received is dispensed to the appropriate director. Thank you for the past 6 years with the board. Time to retire.

Registration – Sue Lidbetter – Last season, a new registration platform was introduced to OMHA players called Sportle. This did not come without its challenges and was definitely a learning curve for all. Anticipating that this season's registration will go live around May 1 and should be much easier to manage. Watch the website for registration links. For OWHA, registration is already live.

Question from Marty Dudgeon – Can we add the medical information to the registration paperwork? Answer – Sue will investigate this as an option. TB – Medical documents can be added to the Ramp registration process for the girls' hockey.

OMHA – Derek Janes – He is the link between OMHA and IMHA. The past 2 years, he has filtered Covid protocols from OMHA to our board to ensure safe return to hockey. His role also manages team rosters, travel permits and permission to skate forms.

Officiating & Gate Fees – Paul Walkom – This year, Ontario Referee Association opened up certification to 14 & 15-year olds to help manage the shortage of referees. This was an on-line learning program. IMHA had 9 individuals complete the certification, the most from any organization. We want to continue building our pool of referees. Paul is the link between the Middlesex Centre Referee Association and IMHA. He also set up staff to collect gate fees. AM – highlighted and thanked Paul for his support in getting these new referees started. Aaron Brooks – it was great seeing these new, young refs on the ice. They had great enthusiasm and accepted feedback. Well done! Jeff Sutherland – IMHA has reached out to a local NHL referee to offer development for our new refs.

Coaching – Scott Parker (read by RS as Scott is away on a family vacation with poor internet) Good number of coaching applications have been received. The organization is growing, with lots of teams at each bracket. Scott thanked all the coaches and bench staff for another successful season. Question – When is the coaching application deadline? Answer – Girls' coaching applications are up online now. OMHA will go live in a couple of weeks.

Equipment – Chris Dixon – this role does a lot of behind the scenes work such as ordering Tim Horton jerseys, pins, stickers, pucks and first aid kits. He distributes the jerseys to all teams. A big shout-out to Pete Sports for providing IMHA with replacement jerseys when there was such a supply chain issue. Chris also thanks Todd for applying for and receiving player equipment. Seeing 2 new players, put on full sets of new equipment supplied by IMHA, seeing them smiling and their dad taking video, was just priceless!

Ice Convener – Grant McNair – This past season definitely had its ups and downs, especially with scheduling ice. Fitting in all the teams within the mandated ice/timelines was challenging. Municipality was really good at allowing extra ice when needed and not charging us for ice not used due to the pandemic. This season, the coaches did a great job of working together to use all unwanted ice.

OWHA – Trish Brennan – this season we had 2 girls' teams in each age group. She highlighted the year's accomplishments.

Fundraising and Sponsorship – Pat Conlin – This year, IMHA hosted many fundraising events including Rafflebox, Junior C game, Silent auction and provided the food & drink at the Shamrock All-star games. We also offered 'Intro to Hockey' for 40 girls and 20 boys. The fundraising credit program was revamped and we enhanced our Social media platforms. Articles were also in the Villager. Thanks to all of our amazing volunteers.

Local League – Andy Marshall – He is the link between the LM and IMHA. He shared the highlights of the season and successes of the teams. Congrats to all!

Shamrock – Jeff Reid – Lots of changes occurred this past season in the Shamrock league. The IMHA Shamrock teams are very competitive and represented IMHA well. At the Shamrock AGM, we have the opportunity to review these changes and offer suggestions. Hockey is changing as we once knew it! He thanked all the coaches. PW also shared how IMHA hosted the Shamrock All-star games. This required lots of volunteers. Over 500 players/bench staff participated in the event. Special thanks to Mark and Cheryl Aylesworth, who supplied the pizza.

Development – Jeff Sutherland – Very excited for the upcoming September development schedule. This will include sessions with The Moir's, Snipe, Brendon O'Neil and a partnership with Clark Singer, from Western Men's Hockey.

Development – Mark Reid – This season, we were late getting started due to the pandemic but each week, 3 hours of development ice was spread out over all the teams. He reviewed some development opportunities that occurred this past season. Super excited for the development plan for next season.

PW made a motion to accept the director reports as presented. 2nd by AM. Carried.

- 7. Changes to the IMHA Bylaws and Rules of Operation were reviewed as presented to the membership. JS made a motion to accept the changes as presented. 2nd by GM. Carried. Question What about the kids that register, then make a AAA team, do they need to register with IMHA and then would be charged the \$75 refund administration fee? Answer This would not affect our players trying out for AAA or AA or A teams, as our registration begins after these tryouts are completed. RS this fee does not apply to our IDP players, they would receive a full refund.
- 8. New Business there was no new business received from IMHA board of directors or our membership.
- 9. Elections MH thanked the 3 board members leaving this year; Grant McNair, Trish Brennan and Tichelle Schram.
